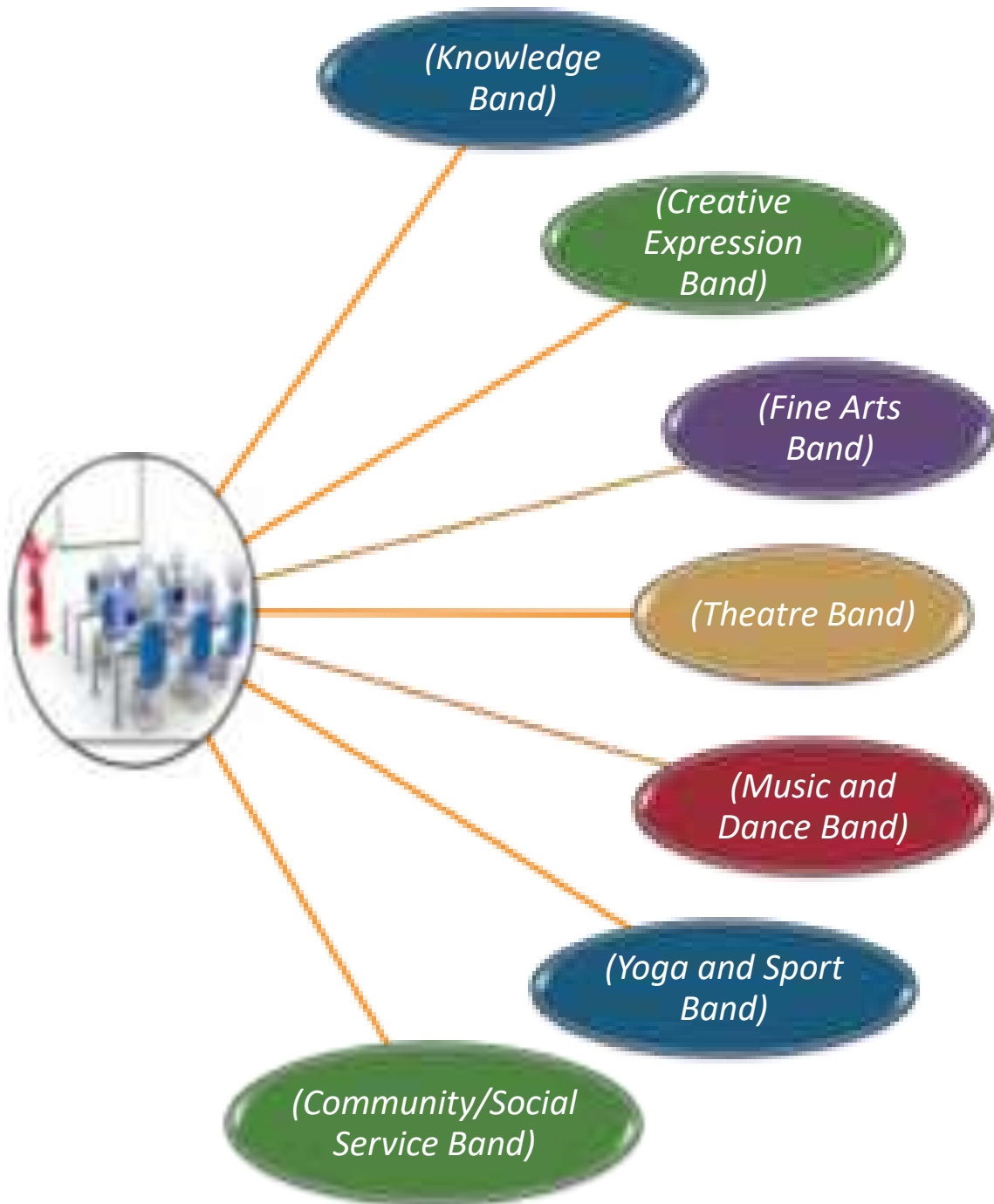

- 3) Activities should build on previous activities and avoid being repetitive, they should enable students to engage with and develop their skills, knowledge and understandings in different ways.**







### **2. Advantages of the Activities**

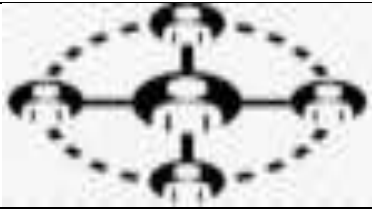

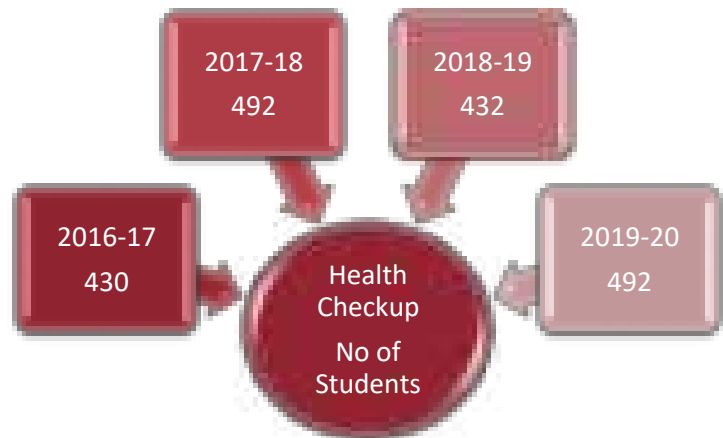
